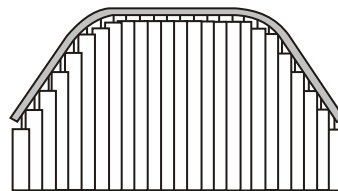
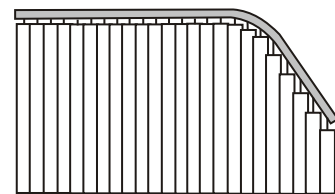
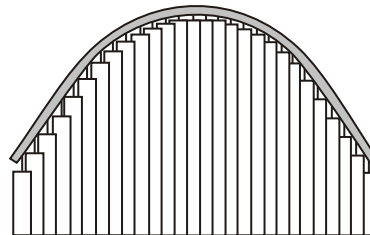
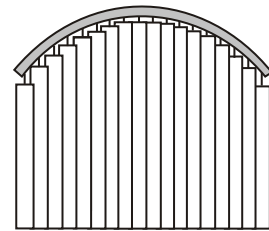
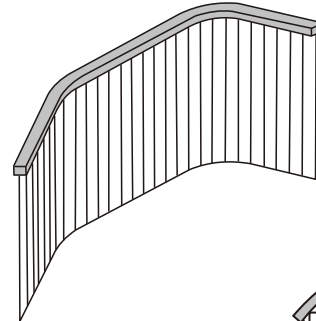
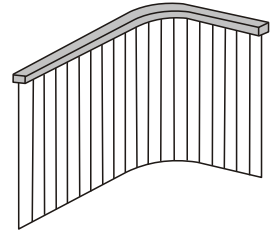
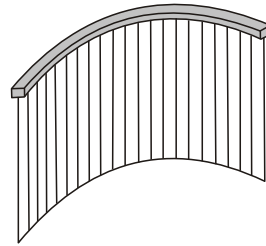




Template Guide for Curved & Arch Headrails



BAY CURVE TEMPLATE GUIDELINES

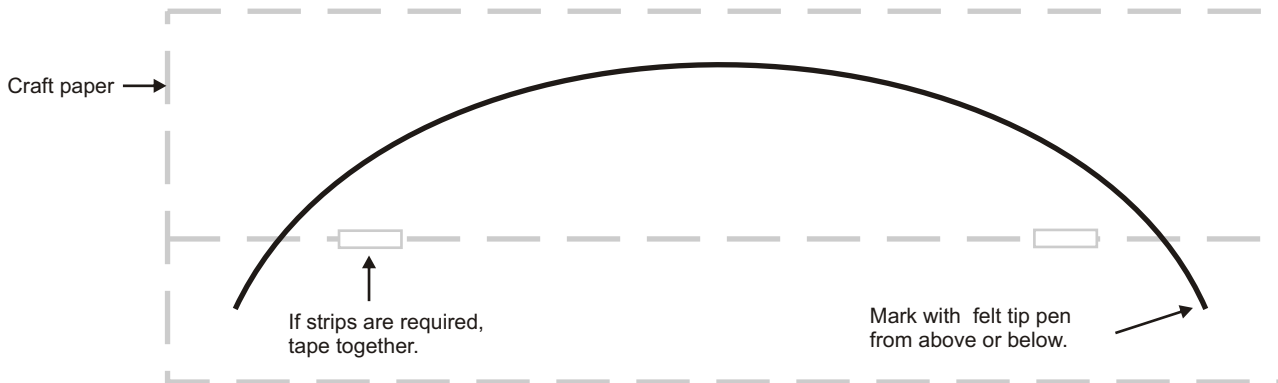


3. TEMPLATE MAKING

Use a 40# craft paper. For a larger window, you may have to use multiple pieces taped together.

Lay the paper onto the window frame.

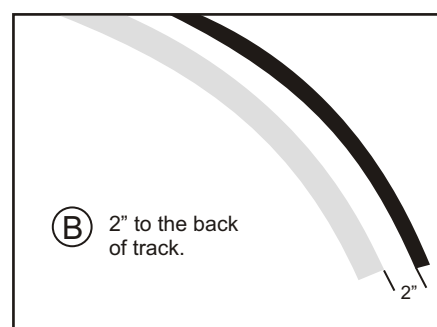
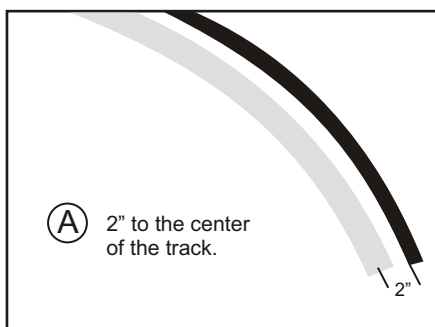
Indicate whether the template was marked from above or below, i.e. looking up or looking down.



4. WINDOW CLEARANCE

Measure the window frame or wall and give us the dimension of how far to come in with the track, i.e. Allow (A) 2" to center of the track or allow (B) 2" to the back track.

NOTE: Additional clearance is necessary to clear the window sill or crank handles.

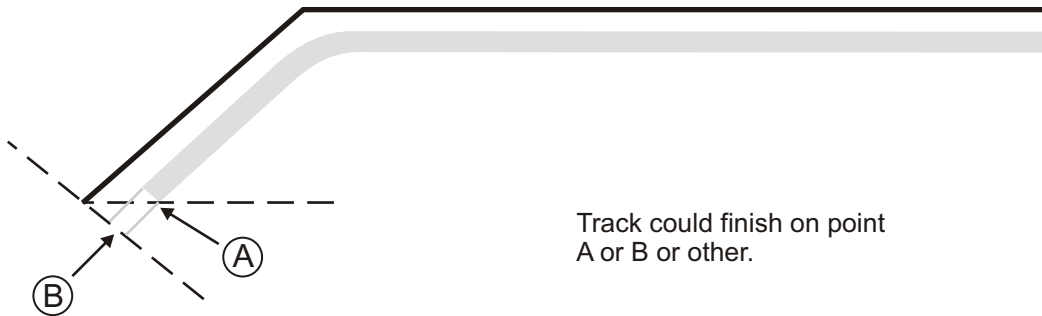

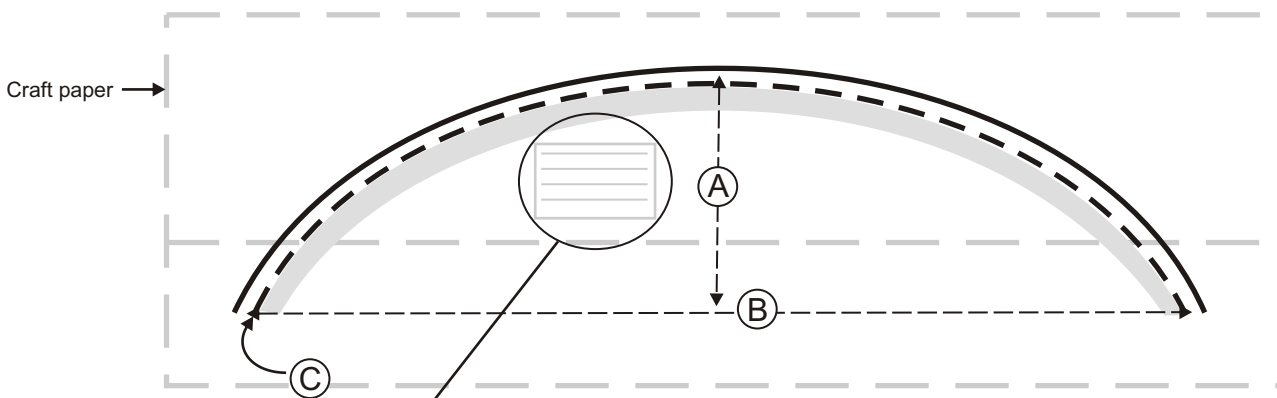

5. LIGHT GAPS

Be sure to mark where you want the track to stop in relation to the window. This step is important to ensure minimal light gaps at the sides of the blind. Provide a small sketch on the template or on a separate sheet stapled to the template.



6. FINISHED TEMPLATE must include measurements A, B, C and the drawing of the track showing the exact ending points and the headrail layout.

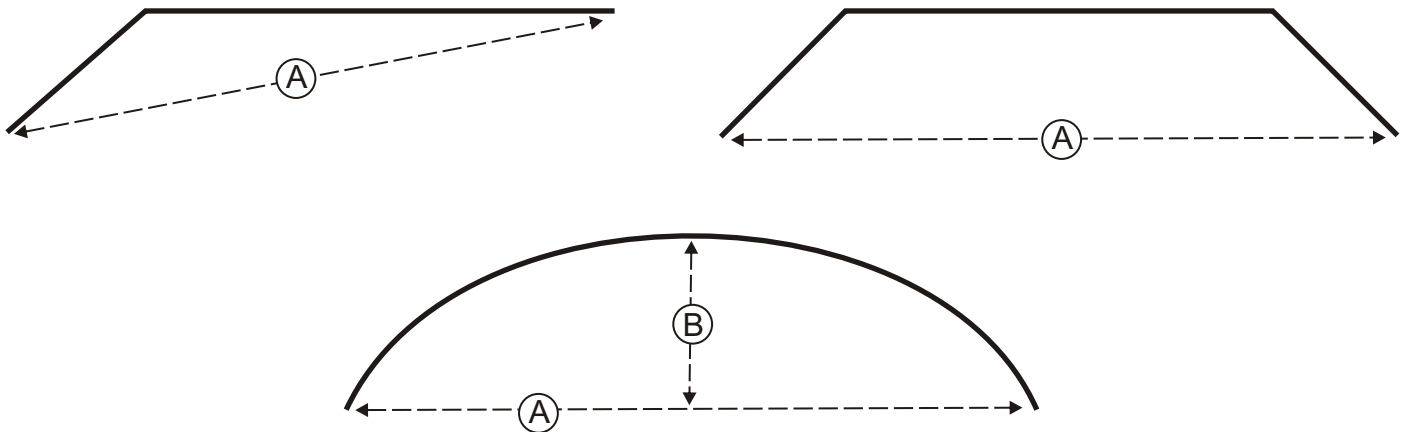

7. CHECK YOUR MEASUREMENTS

When making a template always give a check measurement across the start and end points of the template. (A)*



In the case of a curve, give us measurement (B) as well.

NOTE: This is the dimension across the window frame/wall, not the track.

Pay attention to the depth of the pocket (if there is one). Be sure that you get the track and motor in, especially when using multiple tracks, i.e. Sheer and over-drape IllumaSheer_{tm}.

Pay attention to the minimum radius of the track. The system and the radius of the track will determine the fit in the window (tight or gradual), i.e. In this example the track appears curved and does not show the more pronounced angles of the window.

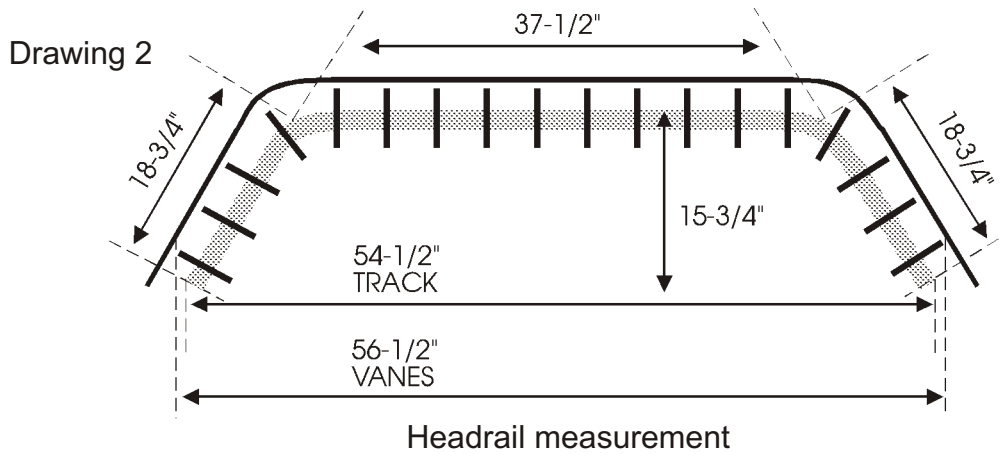
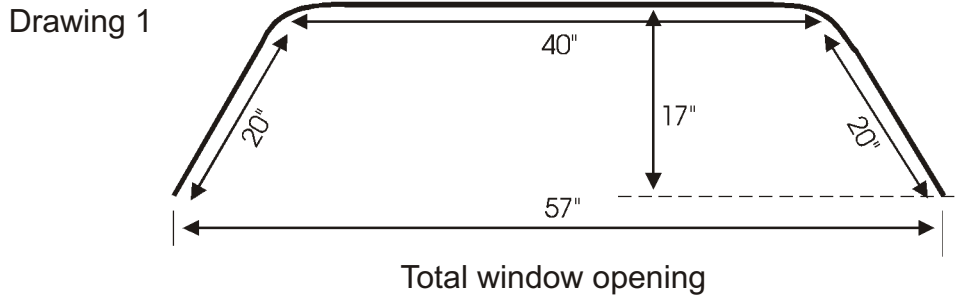
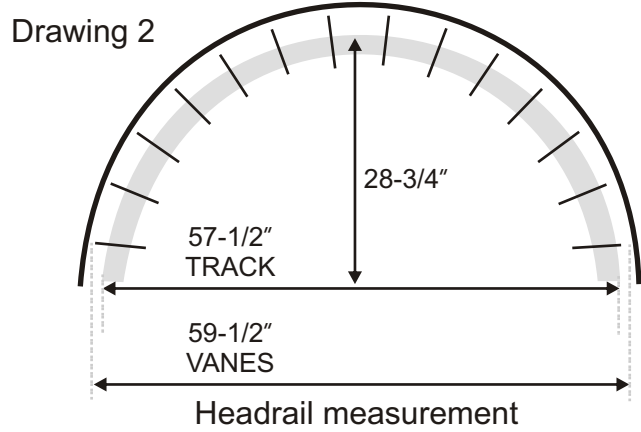
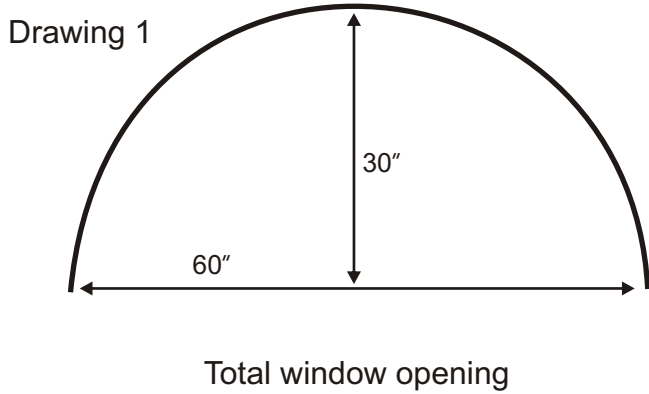


On very tight radiuses, this type of installation may be necessary.

NOTE: Additional clearance may be necessary for window sills, crank handles, etc.

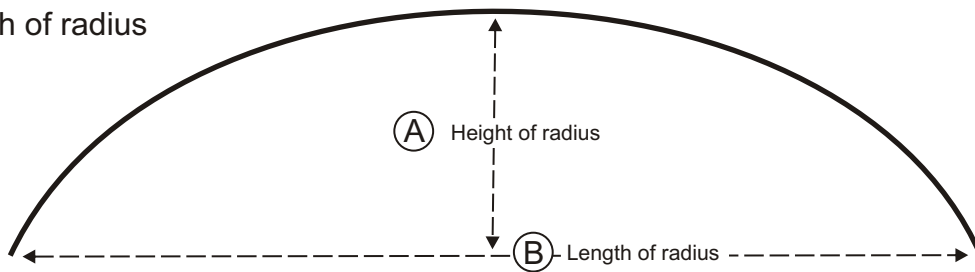

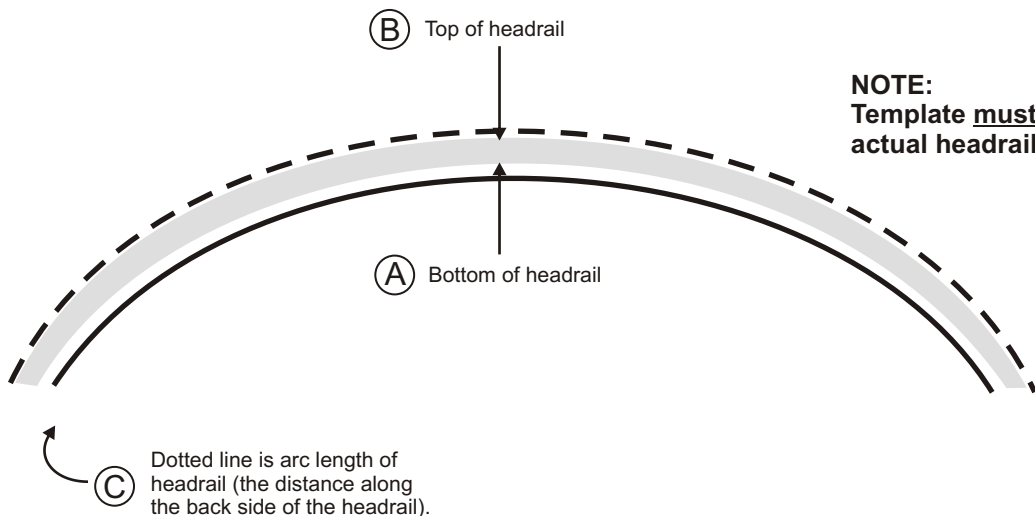
- A. Height of radius
- B. Length of radius



2. DEFINITIONS

- A. Top of Headrail - area where bracket snaps on (point furthest from the floor).
- B. Bottom of Headrail - area where hooks come out.
- C. Arc Length of Headrail - running linear length of the *top of headrail*.

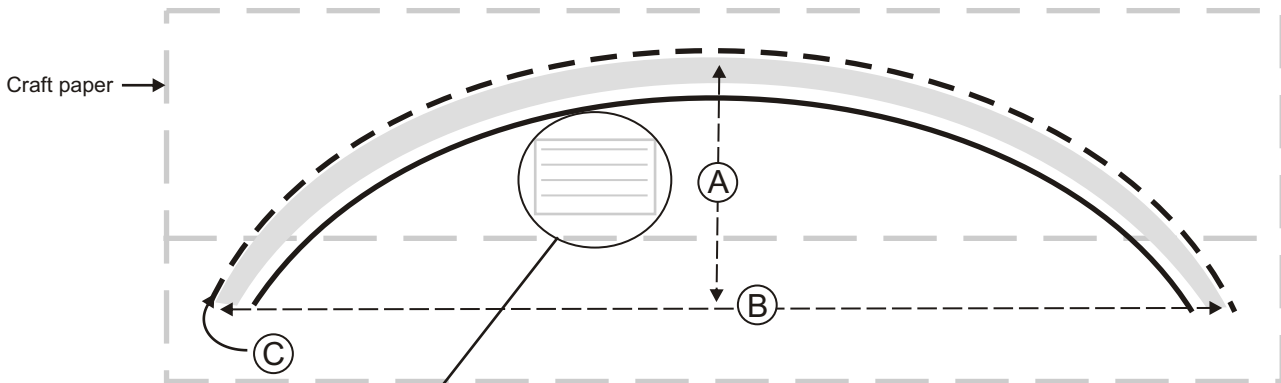

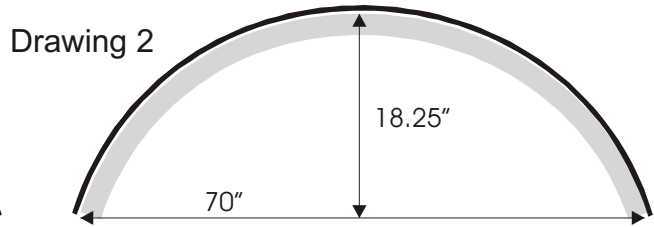

5. OUTSIDE MOUNT *“Recommended”* HEADRAIL SIZE IN RELATIONSHIP TO WINDOW DIMENSIONS



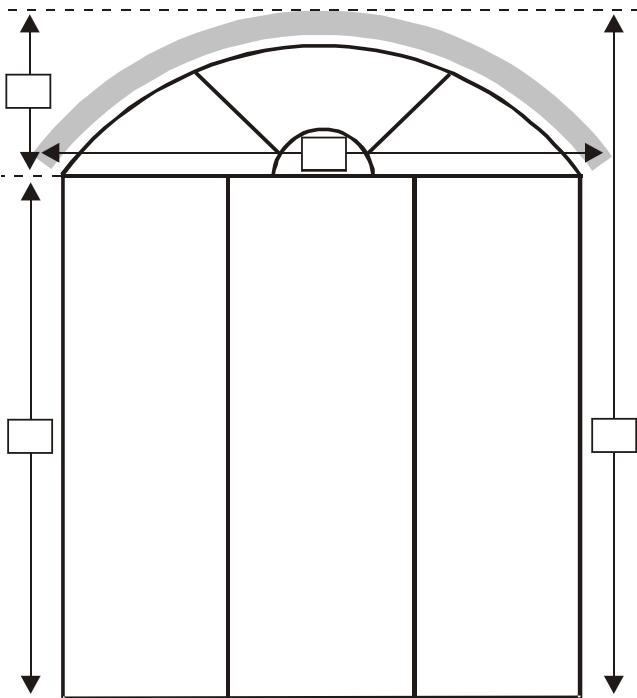

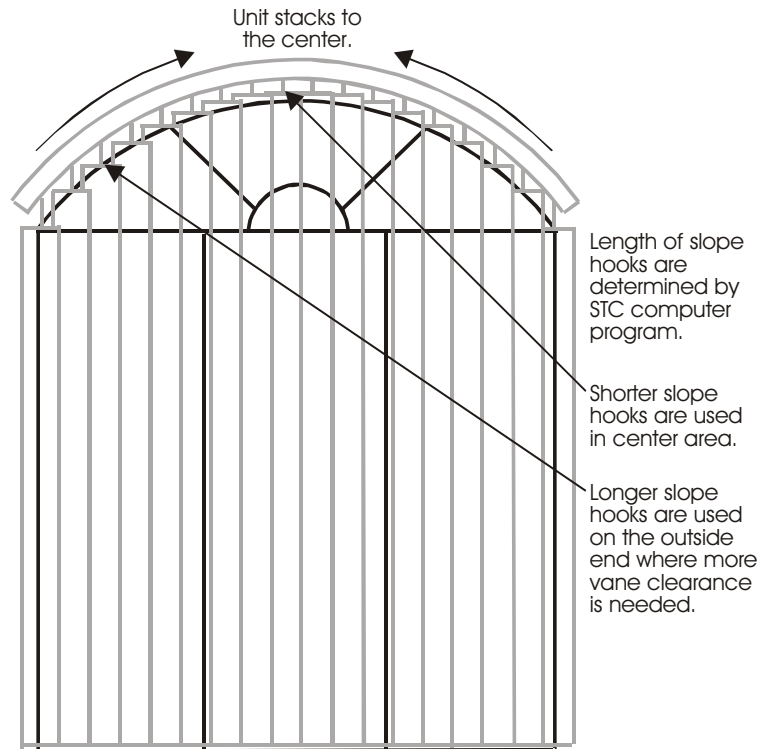
For a custom fit, a 4" clearance is suggested to cut down light gap when the vertical is closed. NOTE: The minimal clearance for brackets is 2-1/2".

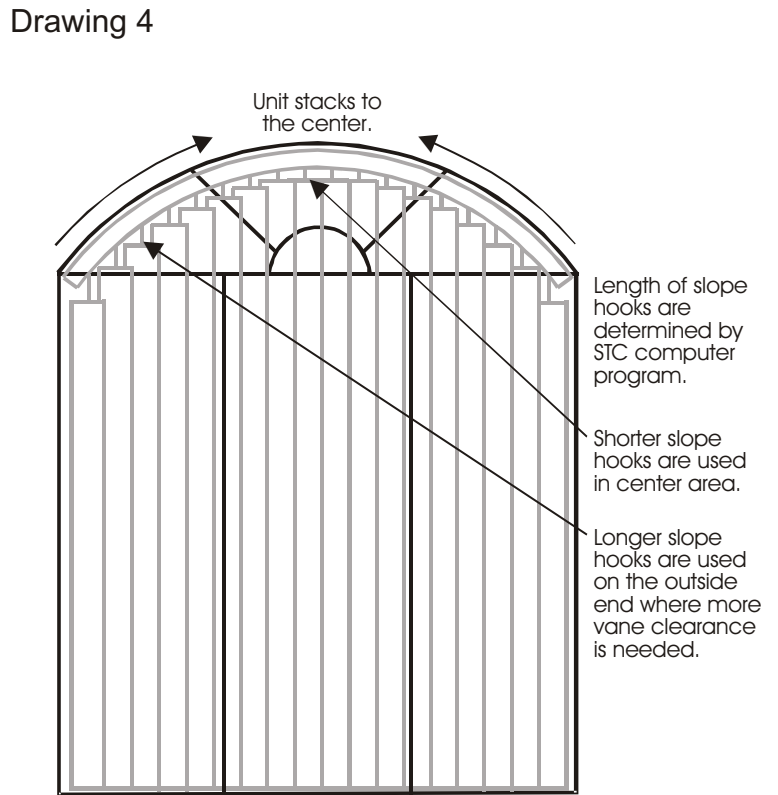
6. INSIDE MOUNT *“Not Recommended”* HEADRAIL SIZE IN RELATIONSHIP TO WINDOW DIMENSIONS

Measurements required for inside mount for arched headrails with floor length vanes.



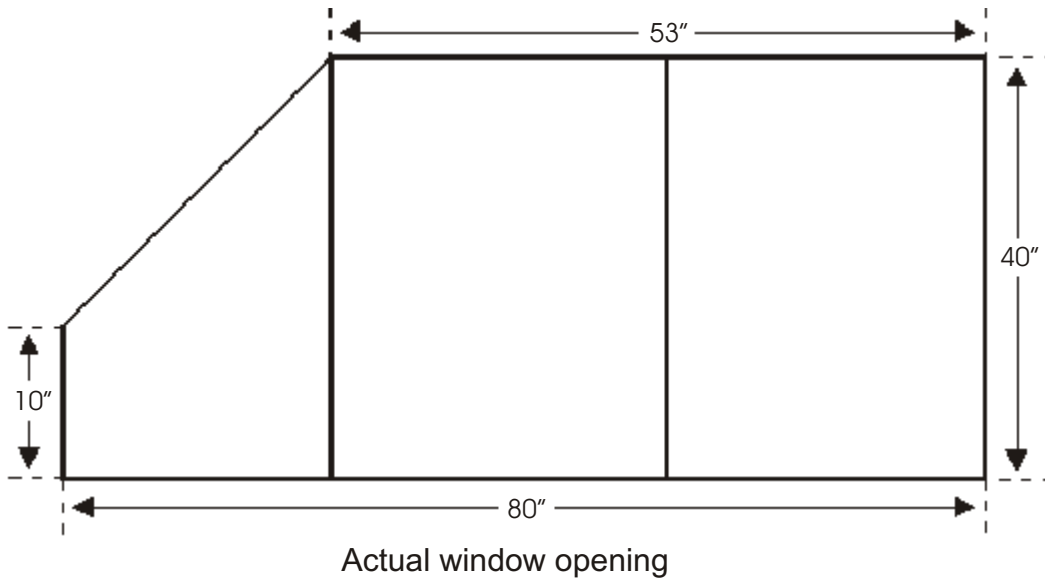

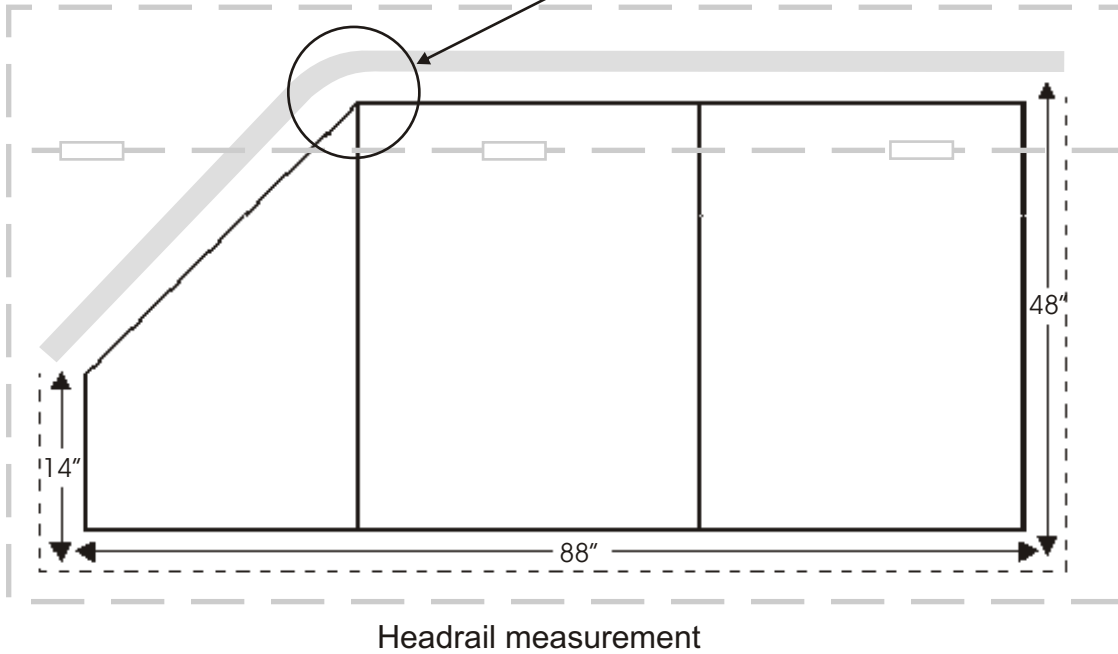

NOTE: The headrail radius curve is not a sharp angle.



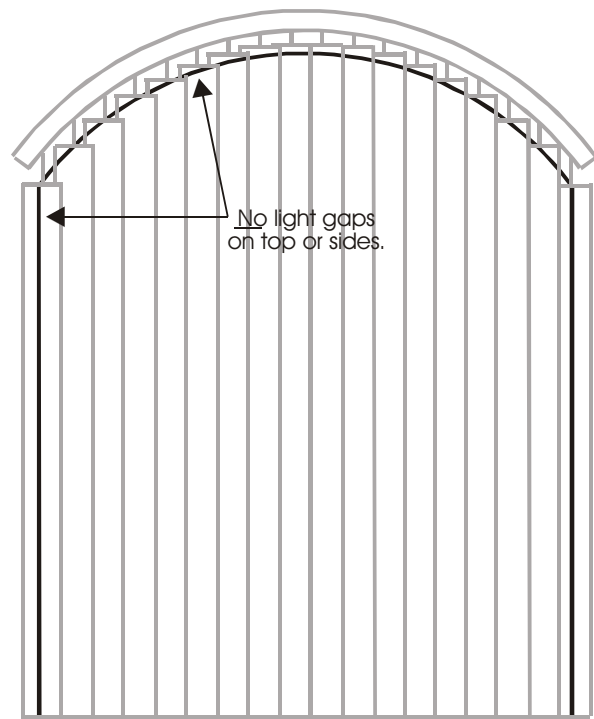
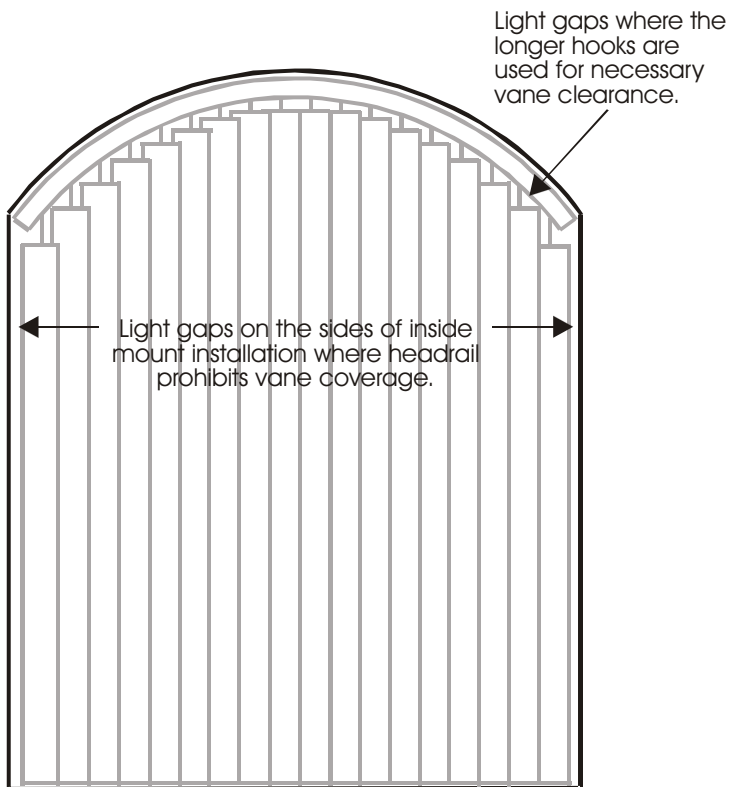

8. TROUBLE SHOOTING DIFFICULT ARCHED WINDOWS

Possible light gap problems on **INSIDE MOUNT** blinds.

For areas where privacy and outside light control are required, the manufacturer suggests **OUTSIDE MOUNT** installations.



The manufacturer also suggests outside installation for a very tight radius or small half circle.
